



Teacher/chaperone code of conduct

The ISTA experience is a learning opportunity for students, teachers and artists. ISTA values diversity and collaboration, celebration and play, friendship and collegiality. These values underpin our practice and inform our development. Our Code of Conduct is based on respect: respect for the people, the place and the perspectives. Being part of an ISTA event involves embodying and modelling the ISTA values in order to ensure high quality learning, internationalism and theatre.

- Respect the laws, customs, culture and people of the host country.
- Respect the ethos of the host school/venue.
- Teachers/chaperones with students are required to be on site during scheduled events to take full responsibility for their students; encouraging them to participate fully, to the best of their ability.
- If you are participating in the programme please ensure that you are punctual, and that you respect the ISTA staff and the process.
- If you are with students please support us by ensuring that the student code of conduct is adhered to. Assigned housing will not be changed, unless (except in extraordinary circumstances) and as agreed to by the host, yourself and the ISTA Rep.
- ISTA and the host school/venue take no responsibility for the loss or theft of any personal effects. It is your responsibility to safeguard these.
- Report any unusual circumstances, inappropriate behaviour or concerns as soon as you can directly to the ISTA Rep.
